Rita has over 50 research papers published by leading international publishers and she has been invited to present her research in conferences in Europe, Asia and Australia. She has co-authored commissioned reports for the European Patent Office, the governments of South Korea and Lithuania. Rita is leading an Emerging Tech workstream at the Australasian Society for Computers and Law (AUSCL).
