Stephen King is a Commissioner at Australia's Productivity Commission, recently working on the 2024 research papers on the implications of AI for Australia. He is currently working on the Commission's productivity inquiry into 'Harnessing data and digital technology'.

Stephen is both a microeconomics researcher and practitioner. He was a Member of the Economic Regulation Authority of WA from 2010 to 2016 and a Member of the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission from 2004 to 2009.

Stephen has a PhD in economics from Harvard University and is a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences in Australia. In 2021 he received the Distinguished Public Policy Fellow Award from the Economics Society of Australia for his public policy research.
